Charles L. Saltzman, MD, Salt Lake City, Utah is Chair of the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery at the University of Utah. A graduate of Brown University, Providence, Rhode Island, Dr. Saltzman received his medical degree from the University of North Carolina School of Medicine. He did his internship and completed orthopaedic residency training at the University of Michigan. Dr. Saltzman completed a fellowship in Foot and Ankle Surgery at the Mayo Clinic in Scottsdale with Kenneth A. Johnson, MD. He is certified by the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery.

Dr. Saltzman spent 14 years at the University of Iowa where he was Professor in three departments (Orthopaedic Surgery, Bioengineering, and Physical Rehabilitation).

Dr. Saltzman has served on the faculty for many AOFAS education courses and programs and has served in many professional associations including the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgeons. He is the current treasurer of the Association of Bone and Joint Surgeons. He has been a principal investigator on several major OREF and NIH grants.

Dr. Saltzman serves as a reviewer on several other journals, including the *Journal of Biomechanics*, *Journal of American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons*, *Spine*, *Journal of Bone and Joint Surgery*, *Clinical Orthopaedics and Related Research* and the *Journal of Orthopaedic Research*. He is the co-author of Surgery of the Foot and Ankle considered the standard for textbooks in this field.
