Steven E. Krug, MD, FAAP, is a Professor of Pediatrics at the Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine, and heads the Division of Emergency Medicine at Children's Memorial Hospital in Chicago, Illinois. He also serves as the Associate Chair for Quality and Safety for the Department of Pediatrics at Children's Memorial.

Dr. Krug has served in a number of leadership roles within professional organizations. He is the past-chair of the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) Committee on Pediatric Emergency Medicine and a past-chair of the AAP's Section on Emergency Medicine. He is currently a member of the AAP's Disaster Preparedness Advisory Council and also serves as the AAP's liaison to the American College of Surgeon's Committee on Trauma. He was recently appointed as a member of the National EMS Advisory Council of the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. Dr. Krug is a member of the Advisory Board for the National EMSC Data Analysis Resource Center and has been an active participant within the Emergency Medical Services for Children program at both state and national levels.

Dr. Krug is the Editor in Chief for *Clinical Pediatric Emergency Medicine*. His areas of interest include emergency medical services for children, disaster preparedness, patient safety and care quality, clinical outcomes of emergency care, medical education, trauma systems, access to healthcare and the economics of health care delivery.
